### TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR REMOTE BIDDING

1. You understand that filling in and signing this form Gibson Auctions Limited have not accepted your instructions to bid until you receive confirmation in writing from the Auctioneers and completed the necessary Sale Memorandum, Special Conditions and other documents supplied to you and the Auctioneer's discretion is final.

2. You should read the Conditions relating to the Sale and the terms set out in this form carefully. By registering for and bidding by proxy or telephone you are agreeing to be bound by the Conditions and the terms set out in this form. For the avoidance of doubt Gibson Auctions Limited conducts its auctions using the Common Auction Conditions (Editions 2) and the definitions used are described within that document.

3. Please note that your completed remote bidding form must be received by Gibson Auctions Limited no later than 7 working days before the auction for proxy or telephone bids.

As soon as reasonably possible after receiving your completed remote bidding form, Gibson Auctions Limited will send you 2 copies of the following documents:

the Auction Catalogue (and any Addendum)  
the Sale Memorandum  
the Special Conditions (and any Addendum to such conditions) relating to the relevant lot you have specified.

If the address for service of the documentation is different from the address you have specified below, this should be clearly stated and details provided.

You must sign all these documents and return one set of the signed documents to Gibson Auctions Limited (together with your deposit cheque) to the address specified below, to be received by Gibson Auctions Limited no later than 3 working days before the auction for proxy or telephone bids.

Notwithstanding the above and the terms of the conditions, Gibson Auctions Limited may in its absolute discretion accept receipt of completed remote bidding forms and/or such documentation one working day before the date set for the auction.

Your registration will not be complete until Gibson Auctions Limited has confirmed in writing their receipt of signed copies of the documents listed above. Please note that you are solely responsible for ensuring that such documentation is received by BRG Gibson Auctions Limited.

A separate form must be completed for each lot for which a prospective buyer requires the Auctioneers to bid. Any agreement to alter any proxy or telephone bidding form at any time prior to, or on the day of the auction must be made in writing to (and confirmed in writing by) the Auctioneers.

4. Prospective buyers are advised to telephone BRG Gibson Auctions Limited (Tel: 028 90 385349) before 10.00am on the day of the auction to ensure that there are no further Addenda to the Particulars or Conditions relating to the relevant lot. By signing the auction contract prospective buyers will be deemed to have knowledge of such amendments and will be subject to them in any event. If the prospective buyer does not telephone and such amendments have been made, the Auctioneer may in his absolute discretion decide not to bid for the relevant lot on the prospective buyer's behalf or refuse to accept bids by or on behalf of the prospective buyer and the Auctioneer will not be responsible for any loss, cost or damage incurred by the prospective buyer as a result thereof.

5. Should the prospective buyer wish to bid at the auction in person or through an agent, such intention must be conveyed in writing to the Auctioneer prior to the lot being offered for sale. In this case the Auctioneer will not make any bids on behalf of the prospective buyer.
